Moldova • April 6 – 13 • Tentative Cost: \$2200

This team works with Phillip Cameron Ministries, now "Stella's Voice," Providence Orphanage and Stella & Simon Houses, ministering to the children, helping with minor repairs, and visiting state-run orphanages.

This team works with Emmanuel Pothen of Influence International Inc. and his father Dr. Abraham Pothen to run medical clinics in a number of cities where their organization has church plants and relationships.

This team works with Daniel Bain, who is working in La Chureca (the city dump of Managua). They will run programs and volunteer with local churches and other mission agencies, including community development projects, a privately funded elementary (Christian) school, orphanages, and a vocational school (learn trades, etc.), as well as work with individuals and families in relational settings.
